

**ShanghaiRanking's University Subject Ranking in Hospitality and Tourism Management:
A Critical Review**

Introduction

On 26th of June, 2019, ShanghaiRanking, also known as the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU), released its 2019 Global University ranking of academic subjects. Hospitality and Tourism Management, for the third year, was ranked as a university subject and a total of 298 (claimed by ShanghaiRanking as 300) were ranked in this subject area based on available data. The ranking results can be checked out from the ShanghaiRanking's website (www.shanghairanking.com).

University ranking in general is not new. The Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings, the Qacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Rankings, the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU; also known as ShanghaiRanking), and the US News World University Rankings, are the four mostly recognised world university rankings. While overall university ranking has been the intent of these ranking exercises since their start, rankings conducted at subject level have been relatively recent. So far, two of the four world university rankings, i.e., the QS ranking and the ShanghaiRanking, featured hospitality and tourism /leisure management as a university subject in their subject level rankings. Both started in 2017 and have published 3 rounds of annual ranking results.

Academic ranking exercises including those at different levels and aspects (e.g., research journal ranking, teaching ranking, research quality ranking etc.) represent a significant institutional scrutiny force that will forge the pathway of a certain academic field's development (Kuhn, 2012). As a relatively young academic field, hospitality and tourism management has attracted a huge number of students and faculty in universities. In China alone, it is believed that over 1000 universities are offering hospitality and tourism study programs and for the time being, around 500,000 students are studying hospitality and tourism or related subjects (e.g., event management) in the country's tertiary higher learning system (China Tourism Education Association, 2018). The fast development of tourism as an industry and its industry scale in many national economies have make tourism as a prominent field of study in the world's tertiary education system. This offers explanations why hospitality and tourism management is featured in two of the four global university ranking as an academic subject.

This paper aims to offer a critical review and analysis of the ShanghaiRanking's university subject ranking in hospitality and tourism management. I claim that while QS ranking in Hospitality and Leisure Management is referred to in the discussion, the focus of this paper is mainly on the ShanghaiRanking's exercise and ranking results in the subject area.

The Ranking Methodology

Any ranking may be questioned by its methodology for overstating or overweighing some criteria while underestimating some others. ShanghaiRanking published their methodology online. For the

subject ranking, the four indicators used are publications (PUB), research impact as demonstrated by Category Normalised Citation Impact (CNCI), international collaboration (IC), and Award (AWARD). PUB refers to the number of the articles authored by an institution in an academic subject field in the evaluation period. The 2018 ShanghaiRanking took 2012-2016 as the collection period while the 2019 ranking adopted the period of 2013-2017. In the subject of Hospitality and Tourism Management, the number of publication threshold is set as 25 for both 2018 and 2019. While the 2018 rankings had 200 universities ranked, the 2019 rankings included 298 (claimed as 300 on the website). It is however not clear how strictly/flexibly the ranking body hold the threshold value of 25 for inclusions of any universities. One question is, if 298 universities can pass the threshold to be listed in 2019, they may probably also be qualified for inclusion in the 2018 round as there is only one year shift in the publication collection. If the threshold is held strictly, the increase of nearly 100 universities in the list may mean that more universities are publishing more articles in this subject area, indicating a boom of publications in the field.

Shanghai Ranking has been using the Web of Science and its Incites database in locating publications. Therefore, the coverages and selection preferences of the Web of Science and Incites databases may play a certain role in the number of publications collected. Personally, I think Web of Science may cover the publications in other sciences areas better than the social sciences subjects. As a result, social sciences subject may be disadvantaged a bit comparing to subjects in other sciences. However, within the subject of Hospitality and Tourism Management, as long as the same database source is resorted to, methodologically, there will not be unfair treatment among the universities ranked.

CNCI shows the ratio of the citations of papers published by an institution in the subject area to the average citations of papers in the same category. A CNCI value of 1 represent the world-average citation impact. The data are collected from InCites database.

IC refers to international collaborations and is counted as the number of the publications with authors from at least two different countries.

The indicator of TOP is the number of publications in top journals in the academic subject. The top journals are selected based on a survey sent to some academics in the field. In the subject of Hospitality and Tourism Management, six journals are selected to be top journals in the subject based on votes of a number of academics in the field. These journals are: *Annals of Tourism Research*, *International Journal of Hospitality Management*, *International Journal of Contemporary Hospitality Management*, *Tourism Management*, *Journal of Travel Research*, *Journal of Hospitality and Tourism Research*. There are 7 survey participants listed on the website, 4 from Hong Kong, 2 from the United States, and one from Canada.

The only applicable Award in the AWARD indictor in Hospitality and Tourism Management is the UNWTO Ulysses Award. The score is dependent on the time of winning the award and number of winners in the Award. Currently the weight is 100% if the award was in 2011-2017, and 75% in 2001-2010, 50% in 1991-2000, and 25 in 1981-1990.

How the scores of the indictors were calculated does not seem to be straightforward. ShanghaiRanking states in its website:

"Different weights are allocated to the indicators for different subjects, as listed below. For each indicator, institutions are calculated as a percentage of the top scored institution, then the square root of the percentage is multiplied by the allocated weight. A final score is arrived by adding scores for all indicators and the final score is ranked in descending order."

The weights for the five indicators in Hospitality and Tourism Management are 150 for PUB, 50 for CNCI, 10 for IC, 100 for TOP, and 20 for AWARD. By checking the scores of the indicators in the list, it was found that PUB, CNCI, and TOP have scores between 0-100, which would justify the claim "for each indicator, institutions are calculated as a percentage of the top scored institution...". However, in IC, there is no university scoring 100. This questions the general application of the above claim. If the claim is true, there should be a highest performance institution as the benchmark and its score should be 100.

Another confusion is with CNCI. In the methodology statements, the calculation of CNCI scores is described as:

"In calculating the score of CNCI, the maximum value of CNCI in a subject is set as the lower value of: (1) the twice of the average CNCI for all institutions in this subject; (2) the maximum of the CNCI for all institutions in this subject. Institutions' scores on CNCI are calculated as the proportion of their CNCI to the maximum value. If an institution's CNCI is higher than the maximum value, its score on CNCI will be assigned as 100."

This calculation is understandable but it conflicts with the aforementioned way of calculating the indicator scores: "for each indicator, institutions are calculated as a percentage of the top scored institution...".

When getting the total score, the squared root calculation of the first quotation above is also confusing. Following this way, the calculation of the total score seems to follow the formula below:

$$\text{Total score} = \text{Square root of (PUB)*150} + \text{Square root of (CNCI)*50} + \text{Square root of (IC)*10} + \text{Square root of (TOP)* 100} + \text{Square root of (AWARD) * 20.}$$

Apparently, applying this formula will not get the correct scores in the Total Score column of the first 50 universities in the list. Instead, I found the correct calculation of the total score is as simple as:
Total score = PUB*150%+CNCI*50/100+IC*10/100 + TOP*100/100 + AWARD*20/100

Some Critical Thoughts

- ShanghaiRankings only rely on the publications in the selected Web of Science and InCites databases and their derived indicators. As such, the ranking only focuses on the research performances of the universities included; teaching, which to a certain extent is part of the raison d'être of a university, is completely left out in this ranking exercise. As a consequence, ShanghaiRanking favours research-oriented universities over teaching focussed universities and institutions. This is why inconsistencies can be observed between the ShanghaiRanking's list of universities in Hospitality and Tourism Management and QS's subject ranking in Hospitality and Leisure Management. QS adopts more perception-based measures in its ranking exercises. Its four indicators are: 1) academic reputation; 2) employer reputation; 3) research citations per paper; 4) H-index. Both academic reputation and employer reputation are generated based on surveys of relevant stakeholders in the subject areas. The weightings were very much dominated by reputation perceptions. In 2018, the weightings for Hospitality and Leisure Management are 80% for academic reputation, 15% for employer reputation, and 5% for citations per paper, while in 2019 these weightings changed to 45% for academic reputation, 50% for employer reputation, and 5% for citations per paper. By increasing the weighting of the employer evaluation, the QS ranking is believed to value teaching performance more than research performance. Research is only weighted in 5% by the

indicator of citations per paper. This explains well why in the QS lists over the 3 years from 2017-2019, more teaching-focussed universities/institutions were found in the top ranks.

- ShanghaiRanking takes the number of research article publications as the core part of the ranking inputs and thus would favour universities hosting large research groups in hospitality and tourism and independent schools of hospitality and tourism management. It is not surprising to see such type of universities enjoy higher positions in the ranking list.
- Universities from mainland China are on a rise over the years. In 2017, 100 universities were ranked and only one mainland Chinese university (Sun Yat-sen University, ranked 17th) entered the list. In 2018, three mainland Chinese universities were listed; Sun Yat-sen University jumped to the 10th while Zhejiang University and Peking University entered into the 76-100 Zone and the 150-200 Zone respectively, among the 200 universities ranked. In 2019, four more mainland Chinese universities joined the ranking list when the total number of the ranked universities expanded to 298. They are: Sun Yat-sen University (8th), Zhejiang University (51-75), Harbin Institute of Technology (76-100), Beijing Union University (101-150), Nanjing University (101-150), Peking University (151-200), and Shanghai University of Sport (201-300). My personal speculation is as China is heavily funding its universities to strive for world class ranking and the funding resources are relatively rich in Chinese universities, more research outputs in hospitality and tourism management will be produced by universities in China. The ranking will see even more mainland China-based universities in the list in future.
- Like any other ranking exercises, even though ShanghaiRanking is relatively transparent in its stated methodology, there is no way that the whole data collection and calculation process can be made any more transparent. As such, the middle steps of the ranking process are mostly in the darkness and good faith needs to put into the ranking results.

The Exact Rank Positions

ShanghaiRanking only provided the exact ranking order for the top 50 universities in the list. For the rest of the universities in the list, they are grouped in different zones (e.g., 51-75; 201-300) and listed alphabetically in their respective zones. This makes it difficult for individual institution outside the top 50 accolades group to know exactly what its rank is. Following the same formula to rank the top 50 universities in the list ($\text{Total score} = \text{PUB} * 150\% + \text{CNCI} * 50 / 100 + \text{IC} * 10 / 100 + \text{TOP} * 100 / 100 + \text{AWARD} * 20 / 100$), one can easily get the total score for every university listed. Using the formula, I calculated the total scores for all the listed universities and obtained the exact rank for every institution listed. Table 1 below lists all the 298 universities in the 2019 ranking and Table 2 below gives exact rank information for the 200 universities in the 2018 ranking. Interested readers can see the moving-ups and moving-downs of specific institutions by comparing the two tables.
